*Wohin und Zurück*

from May 15 to June 30 2010

This first solo exhibition at Galerie Hans Schabus Jocelyn Wolff consists of three works, *Turmbau zu Babel*, *Republic* and *Vogeltränke (to cast one's mind back into mold)*.

*Turmbau zu Babel* is composed of 6 puzzles of the Babel Tower of Bruegel (preserved in Vienna) made by different vendors and assembled by the artist, which we only see the back and not the image.

*Republic* (2010, 135 x 315 x 647 cm) is an installation made from the artist's staircase, and is placed on pedestal portions of the gallery wall at the sill entrance.

*Vogeltränke (to cast one's mind back into mold)* (1998/2009, bronze, water; 31 x 46 x 35 cm) is the casting of the back of the head of the artist.
