

The exhibition

SEVERAL YEARS NOW

Several Years Now is the fruit of a collaboration between Galerie Jean-David Cahn AG and Galerie Jocelyn Wolff. Represented by Guillaume Leblon and Prinz Gholam, this ephemeral, experimentally and collectively conceived exhibition takes place at Grésillon Metal Shop.

Working with both galleries on a regular basis and located just steps from Galerie Jocelyn Wolff in the 20th arrondissement in Paris, Grésillon Metal Shop is one of the last remaining industrial metallurgical spaces in Paris.

Founded in Basel in the continuity of a hundred-year-old family tradition in 1999, Galerie Jean-David Cahn is specialized in classical Greek and Roman art. The gallery's work is unique in how it does not oppose the esthetic value of the object to its initial function, use and scientific content.

Recently at the documenta 14, Prinz Gholam, a Berlin-based artist duo, presented an ensemble of works in dialogue with Athenian archeological sites: the Temple of Olympian Zeus and the Odeon of Agrippa at the centre of the Agora of Athens.

Composing a genealogy of shapes across time and the history of art, their practice summons an iconographical repertoire that mixes epochs and artistic fields, inciting a work of identification, association and supposition.

The exhibition design and scenography primarily developed by Guillaume Leblon could constitute a form of extension of his personal exhibition that coincides from October 19 to December 23 at Galerie Jocelyn Wolff.

Several Years Now is the third project the two galleries have conducted together, following Independent Brussels in 2016, a concept initiated by Guillaume Leblon, and *Palaeolithic to contemporary – Icons and tools* presented at Galerie Jean-David Cahn in 2017.

The place

GRÉSILLON METAL SHOP

Currently headed by Ivan Weiler, the Grésillon workshop has been located in Belleville since the 1950s.

Intervening with architects, designers or individuals, the workshop carries out custom-made work, produces furniture prototypes and unique pieces. In addition to its manufacturing capabilities, it also offers a design activity. This dimension of creation and advice, linked to the desire to propose adapted or innovative responses, makes the particularity of this structure.





A monopteros with eagle

h = 53 cm. Terracotta. Roman. 1st-2nd cent. A.D

Octostyle rotunda on low pediment with conical, open roof surmounted by a magnificent eagle. Its feathers are rendered by elaborate, small grooves. The columns have a polygonal cross-section and stand on a base. The eagle was the messenger and attribute of Jupiter, the highest god of the Roman pantheon, and thus was an important symbol. As a divine indicator of future rulers (*omen imperii*), the eagle also played a role in the life of Augustus. The Roman author Suetonius relates that when the future Emperor was a youth, an eagle tore a piece of bread from his hands, soared up into the sky and then gave it back to him. The eagle already achieved military importance under the Roman commander Gaius Marius, who, according to Pliny the Elder, conferred the eagle upon his legions, probably in the course of the military reforms in 104-102 B.C.


The aquila or legion's eagle was regarded as the highest ranking military standard. Possibly our object also comes from a military context. It may have been used in the cultic practices of a military camp. In any case, the rotunda may refer to a specific building, possibly a temple sacred to the god Jupiter or to the god of war, Mars. Denar coins minted in Spain during the reign of Augustus, for instance, depict a circular temple with six columns dedicated to Mars Ultor. Possibly this was the temple that was replaced by a rectangular temple on the Forum of Augustus in Rome. Inside it, the standard with legion's eagle (aquila) is depicted.



A portrait head of Marcellus

h = 37 cm. Limestone. Roman. last quarter of 1st cent. B.C.

Very few portraits of Marcus Claudius Marcellus (42- 23 B.C.), who died aged just nineteen, have been identified beyond doubt. Ours represents the second, later type showing the subject as a young man who has shed the boyish features of the portrait in Naples (Museo Archeologico Nazionale, inv. 6025). Whereas the round cheeks and hair, especially the linear arrangement of the forehead hair and crescent-shaped locks in front of the ears, are basically congruent with other portraits of Marcellus, our head seems somewhat squatter in its proportions and the facial flesh somewhat fuller, rather like the portrait in Toulouse. To judge by the numerous honours showered on Marcellus even as a young man, Augustus must have viewed his nephew, son of his only sister Octavia, as a potential successor, as is evident from his decision to marry his only daughter Iulia to Marcellus. That Marcellus was honoured in statues from adolescence right up to his premature death is thus not surprising, even if some of these portraits must have been created posthumously. Our head was also intended for a statue. The replicas in Naples, Narbonne, Toulouse and Rome repeat the turn of the head to the right. Remains of nose and mouth preserved. Worn.



A monumental Olla

h = 47,5 cm. Clay. Island or East Greek, Geometric Period. Early 7th cent. B.C.

An ovoid clay vessel without handles.

On the shoulder a hunting scene: Men armed with spears, and grazing or running wild goats.

The human figures are represented in the manner typical of the Geometric Period with triangular chest, narrow waist, spindle-shaped legs and stick-arms. A disc with rays may represent the sun. Rich filling ornaments: stars, wheels, swastika, zig-zag lines, triangles, wavy lines. Above the base, a lotus-palmette frieze.
Surfaces slightly abraded. Reassembled from fragments.

The galleries

GALERIE JOCELYN WOLFF

Founded in 2003, Galerie Jocelyn Wolff opened with a solo show by Clemens von Wedemeyer in a very small space in Belleville in East Paris.


