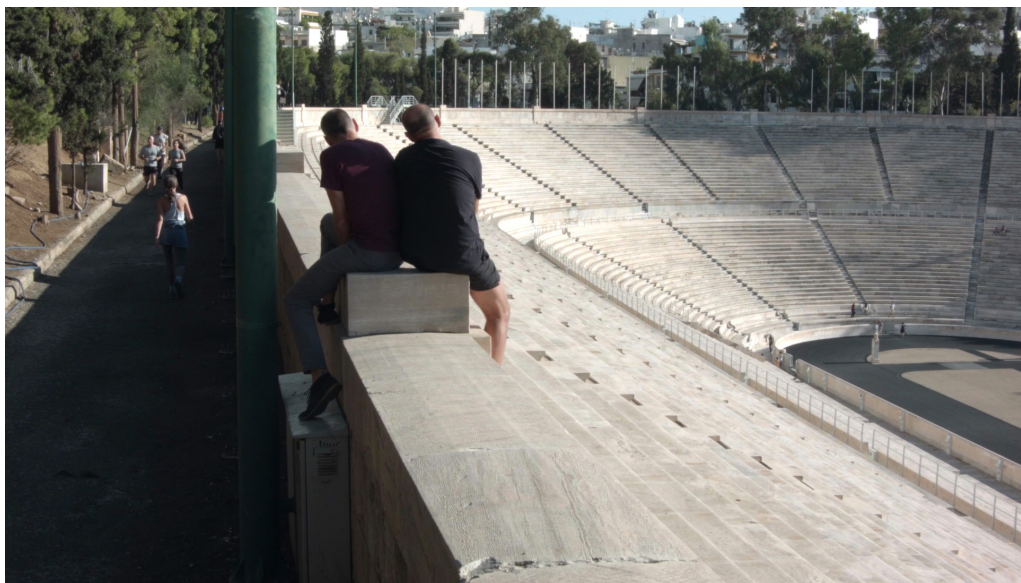

Galerie Jocelyn Wolff invites you to its new conversation series which takes place this year in conjunction with selected exhibitions. Researcher, art historian and art critic Rahma Khazam will engage in conversation with the artist(s) whose work is featured in the gallery, and, on occasion, with other artists or theorists working on similar themes.

This first conversation will explore the common ground between Prinz Gholam and les gens d'Uterpan, two artist couples who work on the frontier between sculpture, performance and choreography. Topics will include their respective influences and inspirations, their reasons for choosing the body as their medium, and the importance of bodily practices in contemporary art.

Wolfgang Prinz (Leutkirch, Germany, 1969) et Michel Gholam (Beirut, Lebanon 1963) met in 1993 and began their artistic partnership in 2001. They live and work in Berlin.

Annie Vigier (born 1965) and Franck Apertet (born 1966) have been collaborating since 1994 under the name les gens d'Uterpan. They are represented by Salle Principale (Paris).

Martina Panelli is a Paris-based researcher and art historian who has been working with Galerie Jocelyn Wolff since 2015.
