The project, "Damage #3", by Christoph Weber was especially created for Willa Warszawa. This in-wall drawing is situated over an existing window, which the artist chose to seal off with a wall. The drawing represents the collapse of a block building dating the 60's, located near the villa. Since the villa was like an island for cultural resistance from the communist system, one can imagine how its architect and owner, Antoni Moniuszko, fantasized about another Warsaw, one where the communisto-modernist conception of urban planning and collectivist architecture falls to ruins.

Christoph Weber was born in 1974, Vienna, Austria. He studied at the Academy of visual arts in Leipzig, Germany and at the Academy of Fine Arts in Vienna; in 2003, he was in residency in New York City (ISCP program). Christoph Weber lives and works in Vienna.
