

Zhang Yunyao

1985, Shanghai, China Currently working and living in Paris, France

Zhang Yunyao was born in Shanghai in 1985 where he lived and worked until 2020. He graduated from the Department of Oil Painting at the Academy of Fine Arts at Shanghai Normal University in 2007.

In the beginning of 2020 he visited Europe and couldn't return in time to China due to the outbreak of the Covid-19 pandemic. Since that moment he is based in Paris. In this period during which it was impossible to travel. This forced him to grieve from a distance and in a different cultural environment than his upbringing. Technology has been the gateway to mimic the closest human connection and interaction as much as possible.

During his education in China there was a strong focus on the history of Western Art, with a firm interest in Italian and Greek Antiquities. What fascinated the artist in particular, was the depiction of the human body, erotics, sensuality, emotions and drama. Many of these themes were not common in the visual historical art language in his homeland. Even today, certain themes and subjects are less present in contemporary art exposed in China.

Sensuality and eroticism is not only present thematically or subject-wise, but also from a point of matter and tactility. While observing black roman marbles sculptures amongst other ancient artefacts, he would contemplate the surface and its interaction with the light. The idea of skin and touch, the tissue that opens up for a variety of sensations and memories fascinates him. It is the physical border of the location of a human being or an object, that defines the space and the volume it inhabits in a bigger field.

Since 2010 he started drawing on felt which brings a very different tactility to his images compared to his works on paper. In many of his works there is no room for failure or erasure.

With an Asian philosophical perspective, he reduces the materials he needs to create his images. It mainly comes down to graphite, felt, paper, pencil, gum, his hand and time.

He creates images of a photographic quality that are often inspired by places, artworks and spaces he visited. Felt evokes the idea of a hairy skin and something touchable. Often it comes with a desire to touch or to be touched but comes with all kinds of obstructions, social and cultural codes. Through his artistic practice he researches themes related to art history, memory, loss, desire, eroticism, power, anger, destruction and the condition humaine, beyond cultural and contemporary taboos.

In some of his works he challenges the relation between different time zones and places. On some rare occasions, he integrates self-portraits in those poetic fields where once again the game of looking and being looked at is exposed.








